## How to Migrate Article-Level, Journal-Level, and Search URLs

Each article and each journal has a unique document ID. In the following examples, this is highlighted in orange.

**Article-Level Link Format:** <http://search.proquest.com/docview/222283151?accountid=XXXXXX>

1. Find the article in the new ProQuest interface for the article.
2. Once you have found the article scroll down to the Indexing (details).
3. Locate the Document URL towards the bottom. This is the new article-level link you can use to replace your old one.

1. Find the journal in the new ProQuest interface for the publication.
